GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIPS 2018-2019

Graduate students may be eligible for a scholarship under several award programs listed below. Please note that students may receive assistance from only one program. In addition, if all of your charges are covered by an external source, you are not entitled to receive CMSV funds toward the covered expenses. To maintain scholarship eligibility, students must be enrolled in a minimum of two classes per semester. In order to qualify for a Serviam or Greater NY Educators' scholarship, all admission requirements must be completed, and applicants must provide proof of affiliation from their declared organization.
