Officer Mitchell, 31, is an eight-year veteran of the NYPD. He is married and the father of a baby girl. Currently, Tom is going through extensive therapy at the Kessler Rehabilitation Institute in New Jersey.

We are attempting to raise money to assist Tom and his family with many of the unforeseen expenses that will be incurred, including those for extensive renovations to his house to meet his handicapped needs and for the purchase of a converted van, once he comes home sometime next year.
