JOB SUMMARY:

Under supervision, with latitude for independent judgment and initiative, the Senior Investigator is responsible for conducting a wide variety of investigations. This is a sworn police officer position which requires an experienced candidate. The candidate must meet all qualifications to be certified, as a police officer, in the NYS DCJS Police registry. This position requires the successful completion of police academy training, in New York State, and requires the applicant to pass a mandatory background check to carry a firearm.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

1. Conduct thorough and professional investigations in a discreet manner as assigned.
2. Execute search warrants and effect arrests.
3. Participate in court ordered electronic eavesdropping.
4. Mentor and assist junior investigators when appropriate.
5. Continuing case management and review.
6. Provide on-going status updates to the D/C and Chief Detective Investigator.
7. Ability to access and utilize various computer databases.

JOB RESPONSIBILITIES:

Specific duties will include, but are not limited to the following:

8. Ability to liaison with other law enforcement agencies, cellular telephone and electronic vendors.
9. Assist investigators and Assistant District Attorneys in preparation for court authorized monitoring.
10. Testify before grand or petit juries regarding investigations.
11. Four years' experience with the SyTech ADACS4 Platform, ACISS database and the U.S. Department of Justice Electronic Surveillance Platform.
12. Assist and mentor investigators in the use of electronic and technical equipment (e.g. Audio equipment, plate reader, lo jack tracking device, mobile digital terminals, and surveillance photographic equipment).
13. Conduct complex and highly confidential investigations and relevant research.
14. Assist and mentor Rackets Investigators, suggest work methods; monitor progress and prepare and review reports.
15. Participate in extraditions and related travel.

PREFERRED EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE/QUALIFICATIONS:

16. **A baccalaureate degree, from an accredited college is preferred. A minimum of ten (10) years of full-time, paid experience in law enforcement or specialized technical investigative work.**
17. **A valid New York State driver's license**
18. **Citizenship required**
19. **Must successfully pass a medical exam, psychological screening and intensive background check.**
20. **Current or renewable New York State Municipal Police Training Certification is required.**

Extensive knowledge and investigative experience in one or more of the following areas is preferred: homicides, robberies and burglaries, major narcotics offenses, domestic violence, sex crimes, elder abuse, gangs, financial crimes, governmental fraud, traditional organized crime activity and the use of state of the art electronic investigative equipment
